#### Background:

Data Dictionary Change Notice 1211/2010 "Commissioning Data Set Addressing Grid / Organisation Code (Code of Commissioner) Update" updated the NHS Data Model and Dictionary Commissioning Data Set Addressing Grid to add the scenarios where an Overseas Visitor is exempt from charges and their current permanent residence is the UK.

This Data Dictionary Change Notice updates the Commissioning Data Set Addressing Grid to add the scenarios where an Overseas Visitor is exempt from charges and their current permanent residence is overseas.

See the supporting information in [Commissioning Data Set Submission Protocol](#) for a detailed explanation.
- Note that if two recipients are identical for example, the [ORGANISATION CODE \(PCT OF RESIDENCE\)](#) may be the same as the [ORGANISATION CODE \(CODE OF COMMISSIONER\)](#), **only one entry for that ORGANISATION should be made for that recipient.**
