Following the January 2018 Cabinet reshuffle, the Department of Health has been renamed the Department of Health and Social Care (DHSC).

- Updating references to "Department of Health" in other NHS Data Model and Dictionary items that reference it.

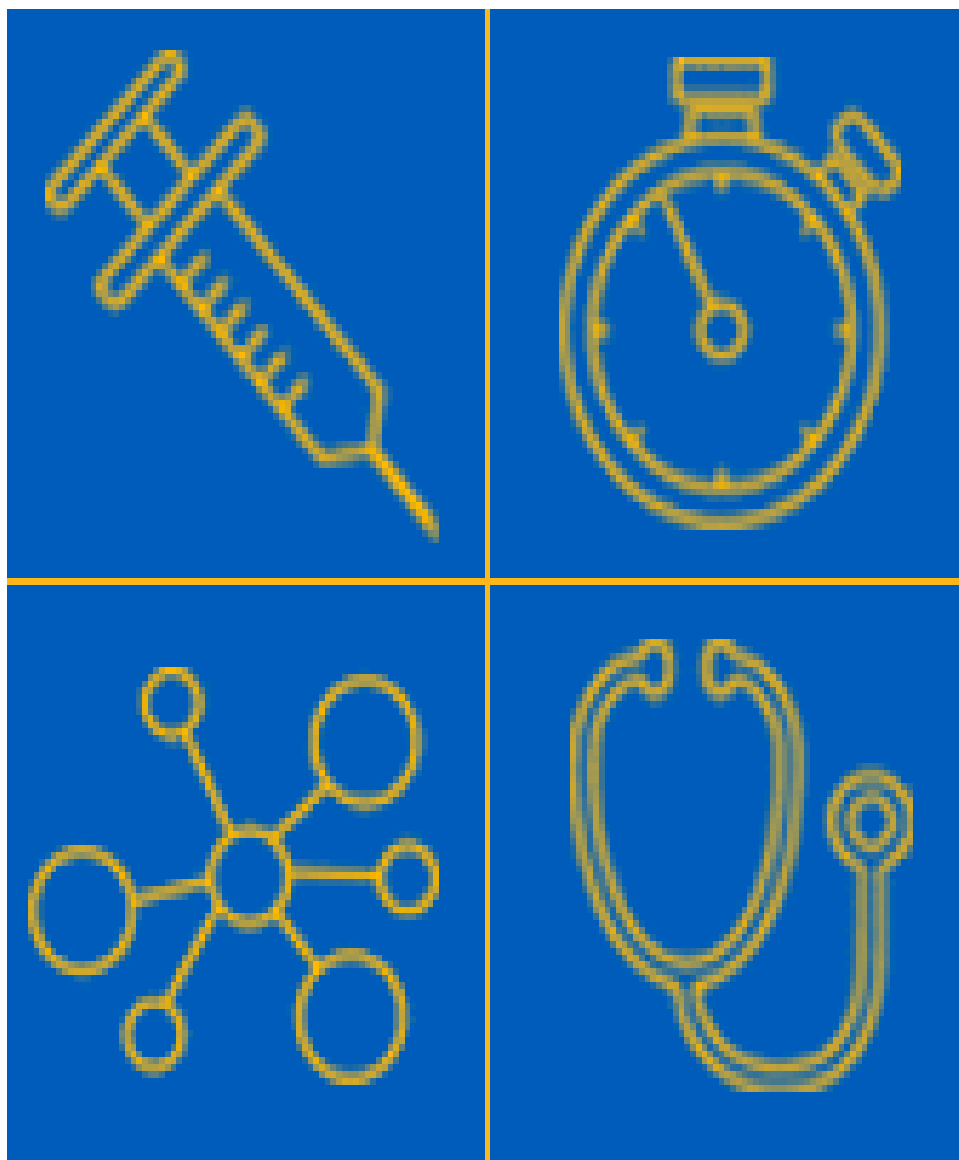
