Background:

As part of the ongoing work to implement a new version of the NHS Data Model and Dictionary, a review of legacy and out of date data sets contained within the NHS Data Model and Dictionary has been carried out.

A number of data sets are out of date and have been identified for retirement from the NHS Data Model and Dictionary. However, it must be noted that the Information Standards still remain and the collections should be submitted as required.

This Data Dictionary Change Notice (DDCN) retires the Mixed Sex Accommodation Data Set and supporting definitions from the NHS Data Model and Dictionary only.

The [Mixed Sex Accommodation Data Set](#) collects performance information on a monthly basis from [Health Care Providers](#) of NHS funded care, including independent sector and social enterprise/voluntary organisations, on the number of occurrences of breaches of the sleeping accommodation guidance. However the count of occurrences of breaches exclude private and self-funded [PATIENTS](#) in NHS [Health Care Providers](#). A breach occurs at the point a [PATIENT](#) is admitted to mixed sex accommodation or moves to mixed sex accommodation from [Same Sex Accommodation](#). Breaches of bathroom accommodation, including situations where a [PATIENT](#) must pass through opposite gender areas to reach their own facilities, and no provision of women only lounges in mental health units, must be recorded at organisation level, and plans put in place to deal with the problem. However these types of breaches are not reported in the [Mixed Sex Accommodation Data Set](#).

Collection and Submission of the [Mixed Sex Accommodation Data Set](#)

- The [Mixed Sex Accommodation Data Set](#) is a monthly provider based return.
- Provider returns must be submitted by the 7th working day for the previous calendar month.
- The data is submitted via [Unify2](#). [Health Care Providers](#) enter their data onto [Unify2](#) using an upload facility.

MULTI-BED BAY (RETIRED)_ renamed from MULTI-BED BAY

A [Multi-Bed Bay](#) is a sleeping area, which may be a constituent part of a [WARD](#), and is fully enclosed on three sides with solid walls (not curtains, as this offers little privacy and does not provide a safe and secure environment). A fourth side may be open or partially closed. The fourth side might need to be open for [PATIENT](#) safety reasons, however a breach would occur if the open fourth side faces a [Multi-Bed Bay](#) occupied by [PATIENTS](#) of the opposite gender. **This item has been retired from the NHS Data Model and Dictionary.**

[Same Sex Accommodation](#) is where male and female [PATIENTS](#) sleep in separate areas and have access to toilets and washing facilities used only by their own sex. **This item has been retired from the NHS Data Model and Dictionary.**

[Same Sex Accommodation](#) can be provided in single sex and mixed sex [WARDS](#). **The last live version of this item is available in the July 2019 release of the NHS Data Model and Dictionary**

In a same sex [WARD](#), the [WARD](#) is occupied by either men or women and has its own dedicated toilet and washing facilities. **Access to this version can be obtained by emailing information.standards@nhs.net with "NHS Data Model and Dictionary - Archive Request" in the email subject line.**

In mixed sex [WARDS](#), [Same Sex Accommodation](#) can be provided either as:

- single rooms with same sex toilet and washing facilities and
- [Multi-Bed Bays](#) or rooms occupied solely by either men or women with their own same sex toilet and washing facilities.

Additionally, [PATIENTS](#) should not need to pass through mixed communal areas or sleeping areas, toilet or washing facilities used by the opposite gender in order to get to their own facilities.
